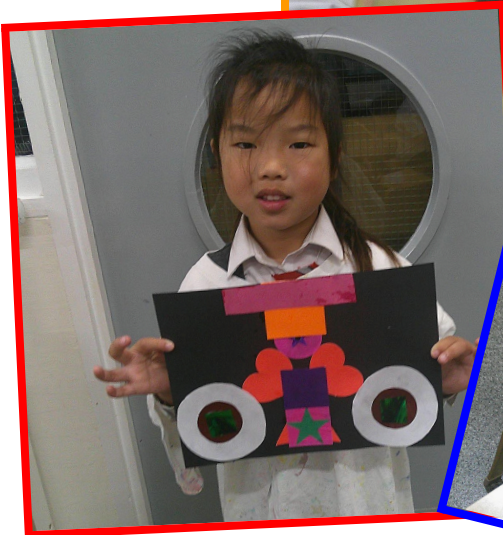

TEA BOXES and FOOD ALLERGY
