

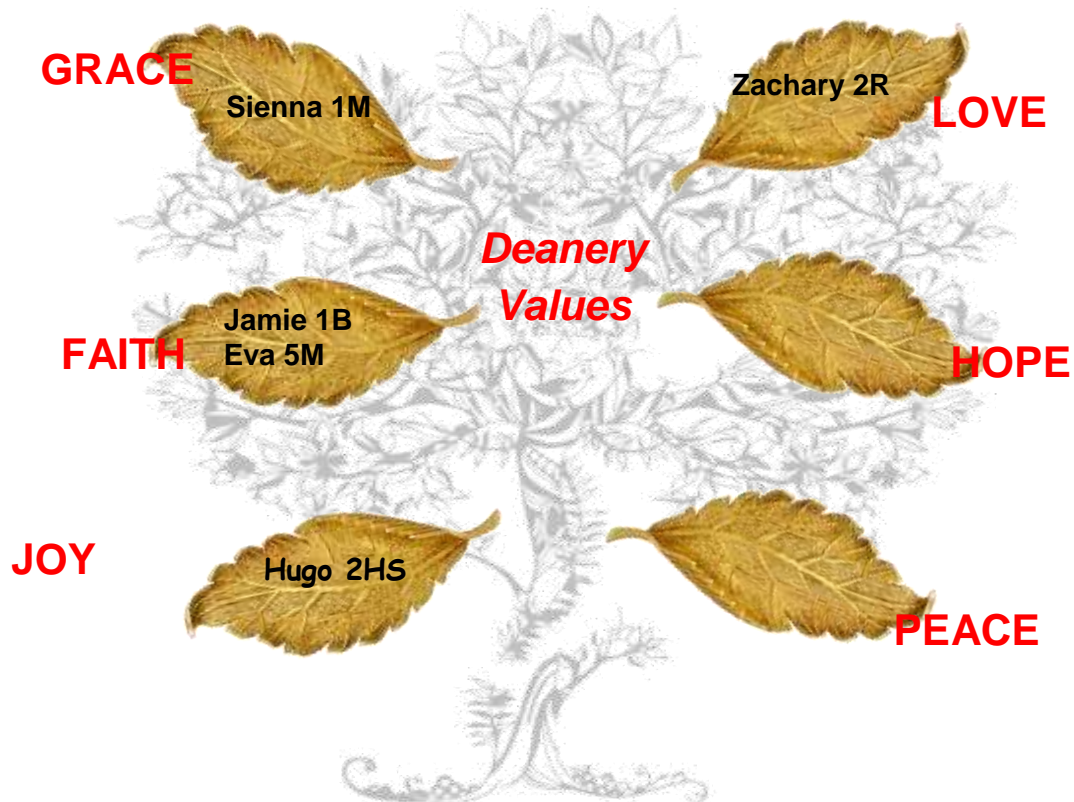
# NEWSLETTER

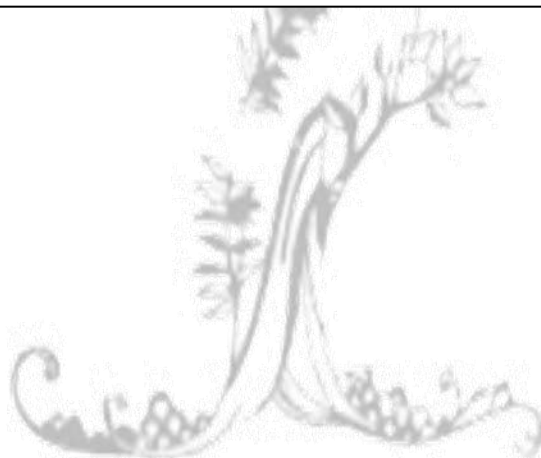
