We are grateful for all members of our school community who are generous with their time to support our school endeavours.

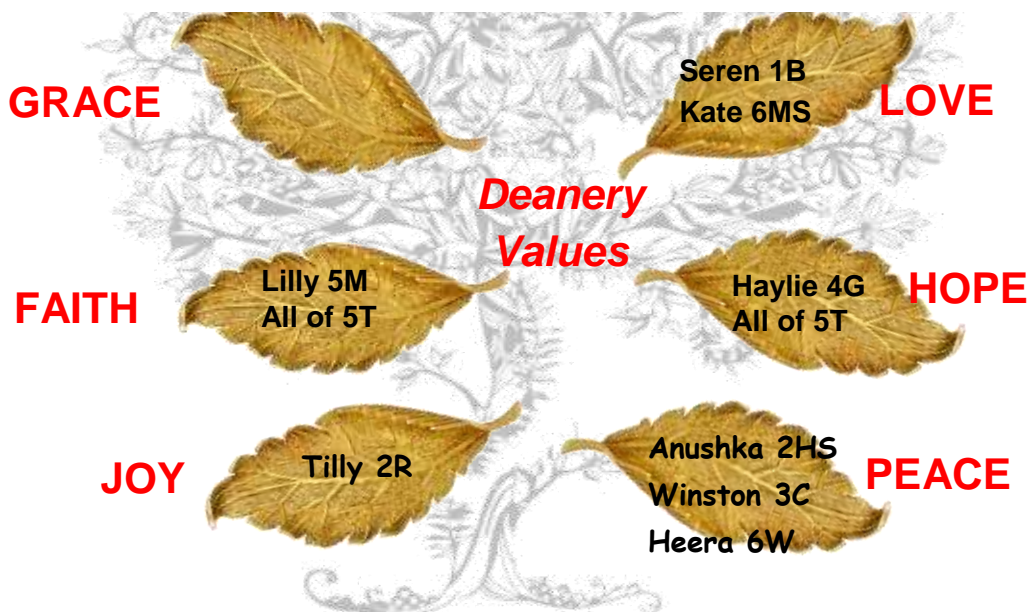

Reading

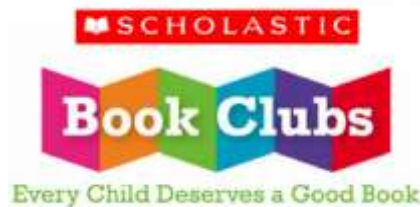
