

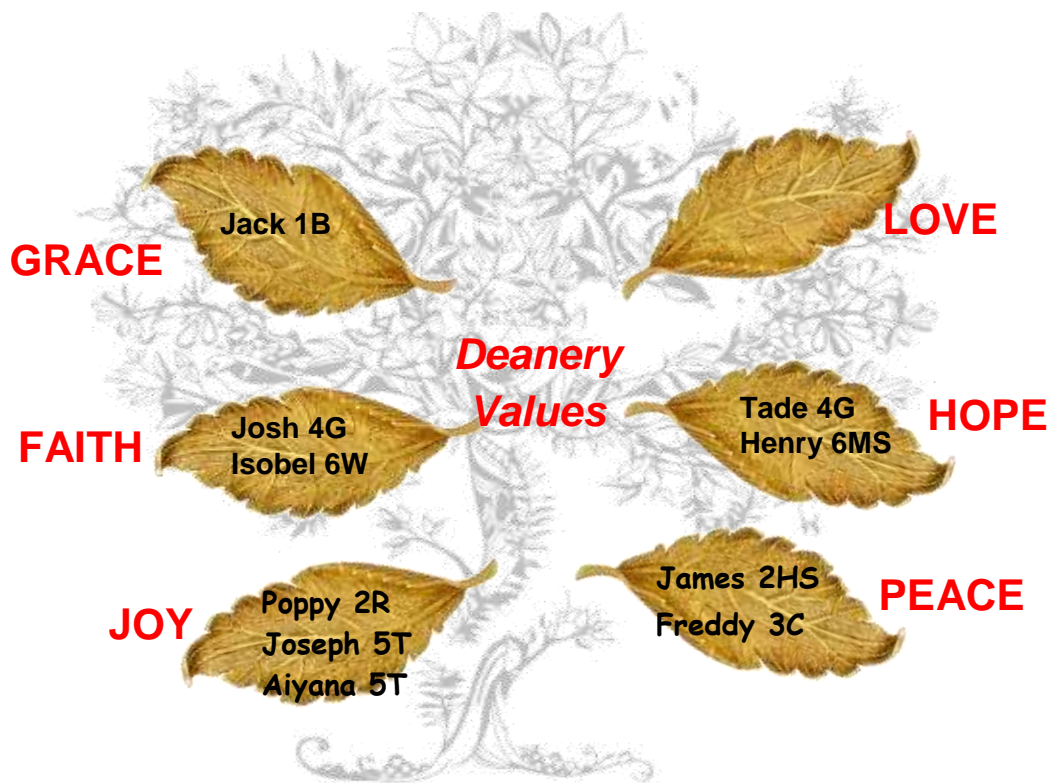
NEWSLETTER
